

#### VINCE'S PARK POOL USAGE & FEES

The Seneca Falls Recreation & Parks Commission invites you to join the summer fun at Vince's Park on Auburn Road. Vince's Park facilities include an outdoor swimming pool, two softball fields, two picnic shelters, and an enclosed pavilion. The picnic shelters and pavilion are available for your family reunion, graduation party, bridal or baby shower, birthday, anniversary, or retirement parties. The Pavilion is available year-round. To rent one of these facilities call the Seneca Falls Community Center at 315-568-6933.

ALCOHOL IS PROHIBITED at the park unless you have rented a shelter or the pavilion and have applied for and received an alcohol permit. Alcohol is restricted to your rented area and may not be carried throughout the park. Alcohol permits are available to individuals 21 years of age or older. ID is required for approval.

Group rates for pool use will also be offered to those groups renting the pavilion or picnic shelter. Rates are available upon request. Please see the other rates below for both residents and non-residents.

All patrons MUST register with a photo I.D. resident or non-resident, no exceptions!! An adult MUST accompany youth under 13 at all times.

# Vince's Park Learn to Swim 2024

Vince's Park will offer 1 session of swim instruction this summer for 2 weeks. Each session consists of 5 days over 2 weeks, Monday through Friday. There are no classes on weekends unless severe weather (2x) causes a make-up date to complete coursework. Each session will run 45 minutes long. Levels of instruction will range from Toddler to Advanced. Parents are not required to attend classes with children. The staff at Vince's Park requests that you do not sit on the pool deck if you choose to stay. This allows for easier instruction from our staff.

Class size is limited on a first-received basis and payment is required to register. If a class fills, a waiting list will be taken. Every effort is made to accommodate as many children as possible without compromising the integrity of our program. Vince's Park program philosophy is simple: quality over quantity.

## **Levels of Instruction:**

<u>Preschool Aquatics:</u> Basic Skills include new levels of water adjustment, underwater exploration, and personal safety without parents. This is a basic, FUN introduction to water for ages 4 & 5.

- Level 1: To develop positive attitudes, good swimming habits, and safe practices in and around the water.
- Level 2: To create success with fundamental skills, including learning to float without support and to recover to a vertical position.
- **Level 3:** To build on the skills in Level 2 by providing additional guided practice in deeper water.
- **Level 4:** To develop participants' confidence in the strokes learned in Level 3 and to improve other aquatic skills.
- Level 5: Skills include stroke proficiency, turns, personal safety, and rescue.
- Level 6: Personal Safety & Rescue, Fitness Swimmer, Diving Refinement.




